Special Election - May 19 2009 Polls Open 7am – 8pm

Important dates:

April 9 - April 28, 2009: Polling location and sample ballots are mailed to voters.

April 20 - May 12, 2009: Registered voters may apply for a vote-by-mail ballot.

April 20, 2009: First day that vote-by-mail ballot can be mailed to voters.

May 4, 2009: Last day to register to vote for the May 19 special election.

May 12, 2009: Last day to request a vote-by-mail ballot.

May 19, 2009: All vote-by-mail ballots must be received by the County Registrar of Voters or walked into a polling location.

May 19, 2009: Statewide Election Day.

Vote on Tuesday, May 19 2009 Your Official California Republican Party Endorsed Positions:

PROP 1A: "RAINY DAY" BUDGET STABILIZATION FUND. **NO**

Prop 1A extends several recently enacted TAX INCREASES by 1-2 years.

PROP 1B: EDUCATION FUNDING. PAYMENT PLAN. **NO**

Prop 1B will potentially add state costs of billions of dollars after 2010/2011.

PROP 1C: LOTTERY MODERNIZATION ACT. **NO**

Prop 1C allows \$5 billion of borrowing from future lottery profits.

PROP 1D: CHILDREN'S SERVICES FUNDING. **NO**

Prop 1D takes funding from children's health programs and gives it to Sacramento.

PROP 1E: MENTAL HEALTH FUNDING. TEMPORARY REALLOCATION. **NO**

Prop 1E takes funding from mental health programs and gives it to Sacramento.

PROP 1F: ELECTED OFFICIALS' SALARIES. PREVENTS PAY INCREASES DURING BUDGET DEFICIT YEARS. **NO**

Prop 1F is not real reform and will not prevent future budget deficits.
